Packing List

- (3) Wax Candle cylinders of differing heights (see the table below for details)
- (5) Metal spacer discs

Cylinder Layout

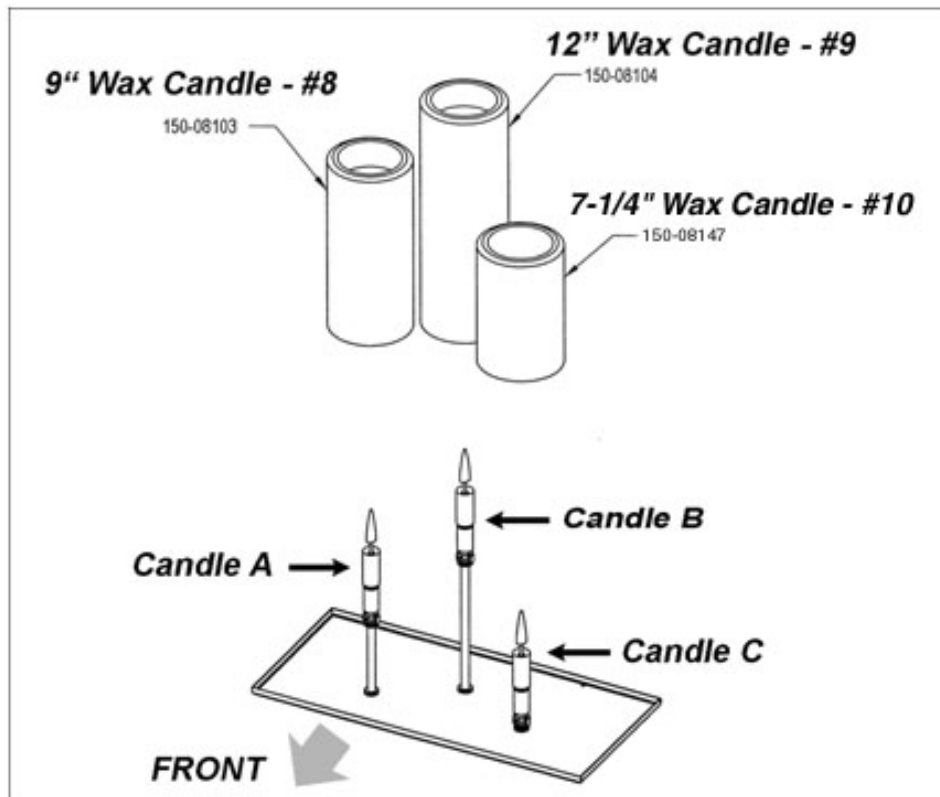
The wax candle cylinders come in various heights. To help determine placement, use the table below to identify and place each candle.

NOTE: The wax candles vary slightly in height and are close to the dimensions below. Use the dimensions as a guideline to insure correct wax candle cylinder placement.

HINT: Start with Candle B, the tallest candle in the center.

Installation

- 1 Follow the installation instructions included with the 1924 Illuminations™ Electric Fireplace through installing the bulbs included with the fireplace.
 - Take great care when handling the delicate bulbs and heed the warnings.
 - Check to be sure none of the wires are pinched under the edges of the tray.
 - Turn the fireplace on and make sure all bulbs are working before proceeding.
 - Make any necessary corrections before proceeding.
 - Be sure you have removed the bag of crushed glass media shipped inside the fireplace under the candle tray.
- 2 Place the wax candle cylinders over the three candles. Place the wax cylinder over candle B, the tallest candle, first. Tilt the cylinder as required, and take care as you slide the cylinder over the candle that you don't damage the bulb. See the Figure 1 and the table above to identify the components.

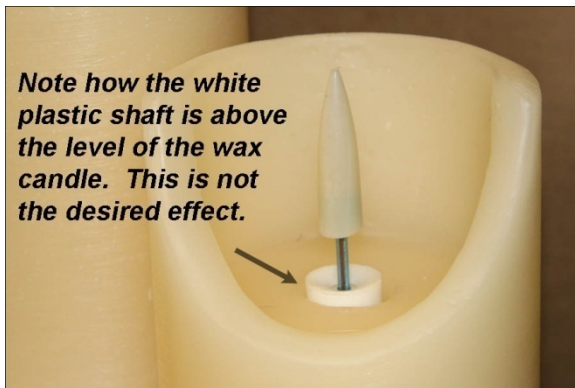
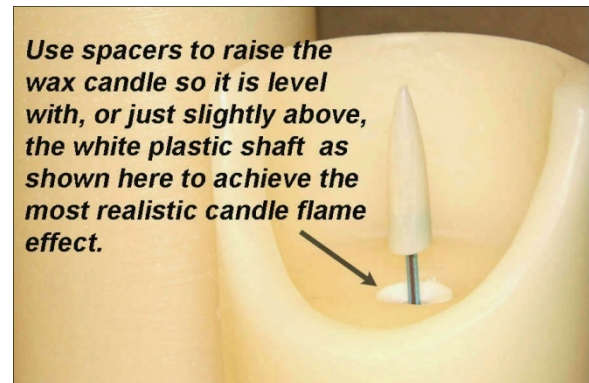
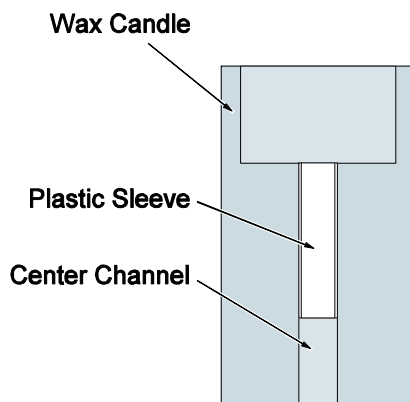


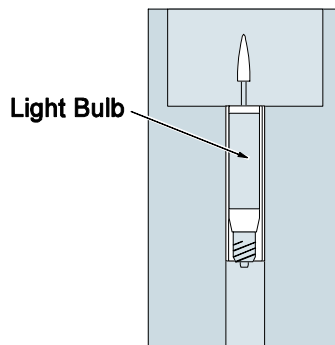

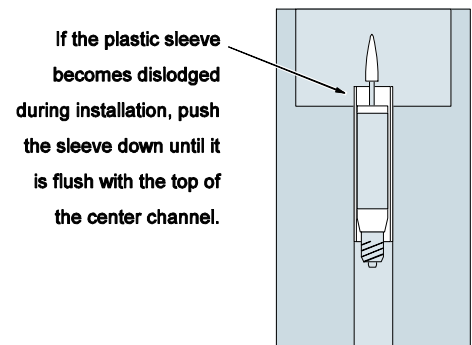
NOTE: The wax candles have a plastic sleeve inserted into the top of the center channel. When placing the candle over the light bulb, make sure the sleeve does not become dislodged. If the sleeve does move upwards, carefully press it into place so it is flush with the top edge of the center channel.

3. As you install each wax cylinder, note the position of the white plastic shaft of the candle bulb relative to the level of the recess in the wax candle. The most realistic candle flame effect is when the white plastic candle shaft is level with or just below the level of the wax in the recess. See the cut-away view of the candle in Figure 2. If the white plastic candle shaft protrudes above the level of the wax candle as is Figure 2, remove the wax cylinder and place one or more of the spacers included with this kit over the candle shaft. Each spacer will raise the wax candle about 1/8". Use enough spacers so the recess in the wax candle is level with or above the white plastic candle sleeve. Place each of the wax cylinders and raise them if necessary.
4. Light the unit again to be sure all the bulbs are operating properly. Make any corrections.

5. Spread the reflective glass media around the candles to conceal the metal tray, filling the entire surface including the area behind the candles up to the lip of tray. See Figure 4.
